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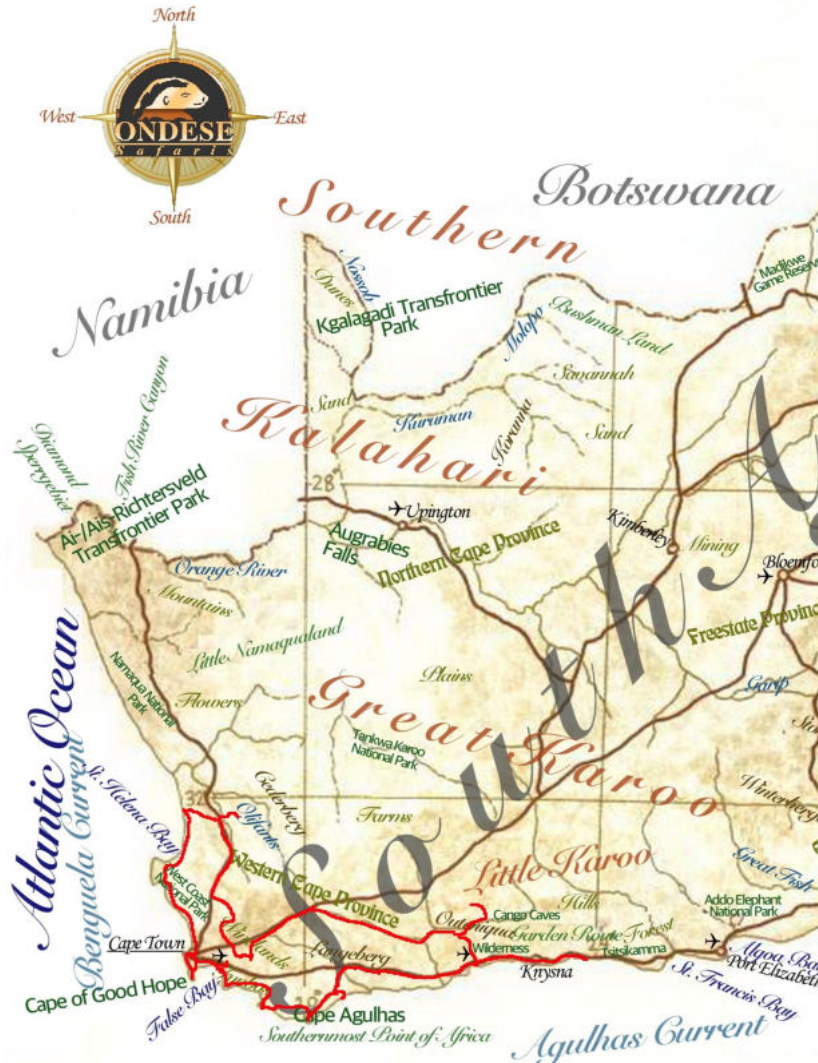

SAFARI IN SOUTH AFRICA FROM CAPE TOWN TO THE WEST-COAST, TO THE CEDERBERG, THE WINE-LANDS, TO THE LITTLE KAROO, ALONG THE SOUTHERN COAST TO THE GARDEN ROUTE, TO THE SOUTHERNMOST POINT OF AFRICA AND BACK TO CAPE TOWN



Short note about the following itinerary: The services mentioned in brackets are referring to the option **Self-Drive Safari!** The option **Guided Safari** includes all services as specified at the end of the itinerary.

Day 1: Arrival at the Cape Town International Airport in beautiful South Africa. Pick up your rented vehicle at the airport or your guide will welcome you here. Drive to the South African mother city and overnight in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Victoria & Alfred Hotel** on the Waterfront. (Bed and Breakfast).



Day 2: Spend the day visiting the Cape Point at the Cape of Good Hope and the Table



Mountain. Spend the day in Cape Town. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 3: Today, drive north along the west-coast via the West Coast National Park, Langebaan, Aurora and Lambert's Bay inland via Clanwilliam to the Cederberg and to the private nature reserve **Bushmans Kloof Wilderness Reserve**. Overnight here in an elegant room with en-suite facilities. (Full Board and Activities)



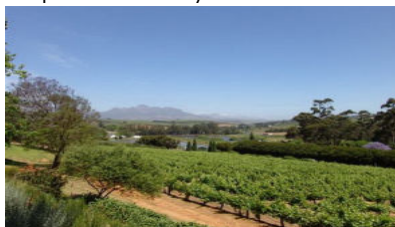
Day 4: Spend the day with your hosts and the offered game-viewing drives and guided walks in this beautiful area. You can also see age-old rock art. Accommodation as on the previous day.



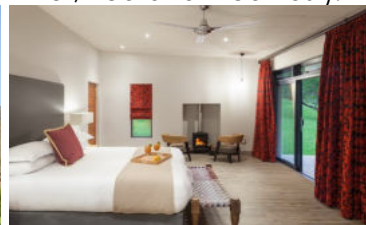
Day 5: Drive via Citrusdal, the Piekenierskloof Pass and Malmesbury to the beautiful Cape vineyards surrounding the the student town of Stellenbosch. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities of the comfortable **Erinvale Estate Hotel & Spa**, nestled just outside of Somerset West in a beautiful valley. (Bed and Breakfast)



Day 6: Spend the day visiting several wine farms and taste the excellent South African wines. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 7: After breakfast drive via Franschhoek, Worcester, Robertson, Montagu and Oudtshoorn in the Little Karoo to **Wildenhondkloof Private Game Reserve**. Enjoy a sundowner game-viewing drive on the estate (Self-drivers have to settle this directly). Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast).





Day 8: Today you can visit the interesting Congo Caves and one of the famous ostrich farms. Spend the rest of the day with your hosts. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 9: Drive via the Outeniqua pass and George to the Garden Route on the South African south coast. Continue through lush landscapes via Knysna to Plettenberg Bay. Overnight here in a luxury room at the **The Plettenberg**. (Bed and Breakfast).



Day 10: Visit the ancient woods of Knysna or you can book yourselves a nostalgic steam train ride along the coast. Of course you can also relax or spend the day on the beautiful beaches of Plettenberg Bay. In Knysna you can visit the brewery Forester's and enjoy a beer tour. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 11: Today, drive west along the Garden Route via Knysna, George and Mossel Bay to Swellendam. Turn south and drive to the De Hoop Nature Reserve on the shores of the Indian Ocean. Overnight in a chalet with en-suite facilities within the reserve at the exclusive **Lekkerwater Beach Lodge**, located on the beach. (Fully inclusive of all meals and activities)



Day 12: Spend the day with your host with the offered walks and game-viewing drives in this unique nature reserve. During certain times of the year you might even spot whales. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 13: After breakfast, drive via Bredasdorp to the southernmost point of Africa, Cape Agulhas. Continue to Gans Bay. Overnight here in a chalet at the **Grootbos Garden Lodge**, which is situated in the Grootbos Nature Park. (Full Board and all Activities on offer).



Day 14: Spend the day with your hosts and the offered activities to the rich diversity of plants and flowers in the park. From here you may also view whales in the ocean. Accommodation as previous day.



Day 15: In the course of the day drive via Hermanus along the stunning coastal route via Gordon's Bay back to Cape Town. At Boulder's Beach African Penguins can be seen. Overnight in a room at the **Cellars-Hohenort Hotel** on the foot of Table Mountain. (Bed and Breakfast).



Day 16: Return your rented vehicle at the airport or your guide will bid you farewell here. Flight home.
