SAFARI IN NAMIBIA FROM WINDHOEK TO THE SOUTHERN KALAHARI, TO THE NAMIB DESERT AND TO SOSSUSVLEI, TO THE SKELETON COAST, DAMARALAND, TO ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK, THE WATERBERG PLATEAU AND BACK TO THE AIRPORT



Short note about the following itinerary: The services mentioned in brackets are referring to the option **Self-Drive Safari!** The option **Guided Safari** includes all services as specified at the end of the itinerary.

Day 1: Arrival at the Hosea Kutako International Airport close to Windhoek in beautiful Namibia. Here you will be either welcomed by your guide, who will bring you to Windhoek with a city tour of the Namibian capital, or you will pick up your rented vehicle. Drive yourself to town. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities of **Hotel Heinritzburg**. (Bed and Breakfast).



Day 2: Drive south via Rehoboth and Kalkrand to the **Intu Afrika Suricate Tented Lodge**, situated in a private game and nature park in the southern Kalahari. Overnight here in a luxury tent with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 3: Enjoy the day with your hosts and the offered guided walks and the nature drive for sundown (self-drivers have to book and pay for these activities directly!) among the stunning red dunes of the southern Kalahari. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 4: After breakfast, drive via Mariental and Maltahöhe down the Tsaris Pass to the Namib Desert and on to **Kulala Desert Lodge**, located south of Sesriem in a private nature reserve. Overnight here in a luxury tent with en-suite facilities. (Full Board and Activities).



Day 5: Today, visit the highest dunes of the Namib Desert at Sossusvlei and the interesting Sesriem Canyon (this excursion is included). Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 6: Drive via Sesriem, Solitaire, the Tropic of the Capricorn and the Gaub and Kuiseb passes through the Namib-Naukluff National Park to the Welwitschia plains and the Moon Landscape. Continue to the charming coastal town of Swakopmund. Overnight here in an elegant room with en-suite facilities of the **Artemis Hotel**. (Bed and Breakfast).



Day 7: Enjoy during the morning a boat cruise on the lagoon of Walvis Bay (this is included) where you may spot Cape Fur Seals and many other ocean-dwellers. Spend the rest of the day in Swakopmund. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 8: After breakfast your journey continues along the Skeleton Coast via Henties Bay through the Namib Desert inland via Uis and past the Brandberg to the area of Twyfelfontein. Overnight here in a luxury chalet with en-suite facilities and with stunning views in the divinely situated **Mowani Mountain Camp**. (Full Board and Activities)



Day 9: Today, visit the age-old rock engravings – a world heritage site – of Twyfelfontein with your hosts. Enjoy the beautiful landscapes of Damaraland. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 10: Visit the Petrified Forest and drive on via Khorixas to the impressive Rock Finger in the Uchab valley. Continue via Outjo to the famous Etosha National Park and to the **Ongava Lodge**, situated outside the park at the Andersson gate in a private game reserve. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast). During the afternoon enjoy an own or guided game-viewing drive in the central-western part of Etosha National Park.



Day 11: Own or guided game-viewing drives in the central-western part of Etosha National Park. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 12: Game-viewing drives in your own vehicle on the marked roads or with your guide in the central and eastern part of Etosha National Park. Visit the fort at Namutoni. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities of the comfortable **Mushara Lodge**, located outside the park. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast).



Day 13: Game drives in the eastern part of Etosha. Large numbers of antelope, giraffe and plain-zebra - and the predators that stalk them, and huge, dusty elephants against the backdrop of the vast Etosha Pan are characteristic of the days in the park. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 14: After you have visited Lake Oshikoto, your journey continues via Tsumeb and Grootfontein to the world's largest meteorite at Hoba. Continue via Rietfontein to the red Waterberg and to the **Waterberg Plateau Lodge**. Enjoy your afternoon relaxing with own walks along the mountain and the view down the distant landscapes. Overnight here in a chalet with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 15: Drive in the course of the morning via Okahandja back to the capital Windhoek and to the Hosea Kutako Airport, where you return your vehicle or your guide will bid you farewell. Flight home.
