

Day 2: Drive south via Rehoboth and Kalkrand to the **Zebra Kalahari Lodge**, situated in a privately-owned game reserve on the edge of the southern Kalahari. Overnight here in a chalet with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 3: Spend the day in this typically red sand landscape of the Kalahari and learn more about the Bushmen. (Self-Drivers have to book and pay for the activities directly!) Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 4: After breakfast, drive via Stampriet and Gochas through the southern Kalahari with its red parallel dunes along the Auob dry river bed and via the Mata Mata border crossing into the South African-Botswanan Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park. Game-viewing drives either in your own vehicle or with your guide on the marked roads. Overnight inside the park in a tent with en-suite facilities of the **Kalahari Tented Camp** on the bank of the Auob river. (Room only – this is self-catering and you have to prepare your own meals. There is a shop at Mata Mata.)



Day 5: Spend the day with own or guided game-viewing drives in this magnificent southern Kalahari park. Accommodation as on the previous day.



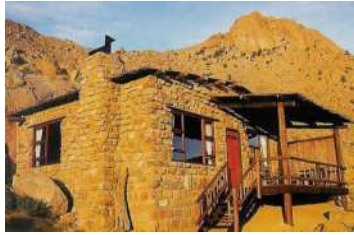
Day 6: Today, drive via Mata Mata into Namibia and on via Koës to visit the Quiver Tree Forest close to Keetmanshoop. Continue via the town and Seeheim to the western side of the spectacular Fish River Canyon. Overnight here in a chalet with en-suite facilities of the **Fish River Lodge**, situated on the edge of the canyon. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 7: Visit the famous Fish River Canyon, a vast, deep and convoluted incision in the rugged landscape. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 8: Continue driving south to the Orange (Gariep) River through spectacular landscapes and on via the mining town of Rosh Pinah to Aus on the edge of the Namib Desert. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Klein-Aus Eagle's Nest**. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast) At sundown, visit the wild horses at Garub in the Namib.



Day 9: Drive west through the picturesque southern Namib and the restricted Diamond Area to the little harbour town of Lüderitzbucht. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Lüderitz Nest Hotel** on the beach. (Bed and Breakfast) In the afternoon, visit the surrounding bays and Dias Point.



Day 10: After breakfast you will have the choice to be picked up at your hotel and enjoy a guided safari through the Tsau//Khaeb-Sperrgebiet National Park, while visiting old mining towns, learning more about the past and present diamond mining and about the sensitive ecology of this area. Visit the unique rock-arch Bogenfels. (*This guided excursion is excluded and you have to pay for this directly.*) Otherwise just enjoy the day in and around Lüderitz and with a boat cruise to Halifax Island (included). Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 11: Visit the ghost town of Kolmannskuppe and drive inland through the desert and via Aus through breathtaking landscape of the Neisip and Tiras plains along the edge of the desert to the **Wolwedans Dune Camp**, situated within the private NamibRand Nature Reserve on the edge of the desert. Overnight here in a luxury tent with en-suite facilities. (Fully Inclusive of all meals and activities)



Day 12: Spend the day with your hosts and the landscape drives through spectacular desert landscapes and the Namib sand-sea. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 13: Visit the Sesriem canyon and the highest dunes of the Namib at Sossusvlei inside the Namib-Naukluft National Park on your own. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 14: After breakfast drive via the Remhoogte pass and Rehoboth to the mountainous Khomas-Hochland and the **GocheGanas Lodge**, situated in a private game reserve just south of the capital Windhoek. Overnight in an elegant room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast) This is a well-known wellness resort which also offers a wide variety of game species and game-viewing drives.



Day 15: Return your rented vehicle at the Hosea Kutako International Airport or allow your guide to transfer you to the airport for your flight out.

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
