Short note about the following itinerary: The services mentioned in brackets are referring to the option **Self-Drive Safari!** The option **Guided Safari** includes all services as specified at the end of the itinerary.

Day 1: Arrival at the Johannesburg O. R. Tambo International Airport in beautiful South Africa. Pick up your rented vehicle or your experienced **ONDESE** guide/driver welcomes you here. Drive to town and visit the Gold Reef City theme park, the historical heart of this bustling city. Overnight in an elegant room with en-suite facilities of the **Michelangelo Hotel** in the suburb Sandton. (Bed and Breakfast)



Day 2: After breakfast drive via Witbank and Middelburg (here you can visit Botshabelo) in

Mpumalanga Province and on via Lydenburg to the charming historical mining village of Pilgrim's Rest. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Royal Hotel**. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 3: Drive through the Drakensberg and visit the Blyde River Canyon Park and continue via Hoedspruit and Mica to the stylish **Garonga Safari Camp**, situated in the private Makalali Game Park in the Limpopo Province. Besides game drives, you can also enjoy aroma-therapy treatments at own expenses in this lodge. Overnight here in a luxury tent with en-suite facilities. (Full Board and Activities)



Day 4: Spend the day with the offered game-viewing activities on offer and relax here. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 5: Today, drive via Mica and Hoedspruit through the Orpen Gate into the famous Kruger National Park. Game-viewing drives either with your guide or in your own rented vehicle on the marked roads towards the southern part of the park. Overnight in a luxurious room with en-suite facilities at **Jack Safari Lodge** inside the park. (Full Board and Activities)



Day 6: Spend the day with guided game-viewing drives in the Kruger National Park with your expert guide. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 7: Exit the Kruger National Park through the southern Malelane Gate and drive via Jeppe's Reef to the small Kingdom of Eswatini (Swaziland). Continue through mountainous landscapes via Piggs Peak and the glass works at Ngwenya and the capital Mbabane to the **Reilly's Rock Hilltop Lodge** in the Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 8: Drive via Manzini and Big Bend through southern eSwatini and exit that country at Lavumisa to the South African province of KwaZulu-Natal and continue via Mkuze and Hluhluwe to the oldest South African national park, the Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Park. Game-viewing drives either in your own rented vehicle or with your guide on the marked roads in this beautiful park. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities at **Hilltop Rest Camp** inside the park, managed by the KwaZulu-Natal Conservation Services. (Dinner, Bed, Breakfast and one guided game-viewing drive.)



Day 9: Own or guided game-viewing drives through the hills of the Hluhluwe-Imfolozi National Park. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 10: Spend the day in this spectacular park. As on the previous day.

Day 11: Today, exit the national parks and drive via Mtubatuba to the unique wetlands of iSimangaliso (St. Lucia), a world heritage site. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Makakatana Bay Lodge**, situated on the shores of Lake St. Lucia, but also has access to the beautiful beaches of the Indian Ocean. (Full Board and activities on offer)



Day 12: Spend the day with your hosts and the offered excursions along the lake and to the beach. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 13: In the course of the morning, drive via Richard's Bay along the Indian Ocean through to Zululand and on to **Shakaland**. Spend the day here and learn more about the Zulu culture. Overnight in a traditional styled room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed, Breakfast and a cultural experience)



Day 14: In the course of the morning drive to the harbour city of Durban. You can visit the Indian market, the aquarium and the harbour. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities at the elegant **Balmoral Hotel**, situated close to the beach of Durban's Golden Mile. (Bed and Breakfast).



Day 15: Your guide bids you farewell at the Durban King Shaka International Airport or you return your rented vehicle here. Flight home.
