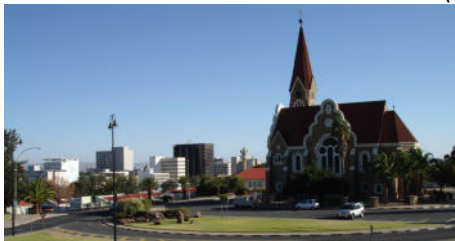


HOOK-LIPPED RHINOCEROS SAFARI – 14 DAYS (NAM) SAFARI IN NAMIBIA FROM THE CAPITAL WINDHOEK TO THE NAMIB DESERT, THE SKELETON COAST, DAMARALAND AND TO ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK



Short note about the following itinerary: The services mentioned in brackets are referring to the option **Self-Drive Safari!** The option **Guided Safari** includes all services as specified at the end of the itinerary.

Day 1: Arrival at the Hosea Kutako International Airport, Windhoek in beautiful Namibia. Here your guide welcomes you, or you pick up your rented vehicle. Drive to the buzzing Namibian capital Windhoek and overnight in an elegant room with en-suite facilities of **Hilton Windhoek Hotel**. (Bed and Breakfast)



Day 2: After breakfast, drive either on the tared road via Okahandja, Karibib and Usakos to Swakopmund or through the mountainous Khomas Hochland, down the Bosua Pass into the Namib Desert. You reach the Welwitschia plains and the Moon Landscape in the Namib-Naukluft National Park. In the late afternoon you arrive in the charming coastal town of Swakopmund. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Swakopmund Strand Hotel**. (Bed and Breakfast)



Day 3: During the morning, enjoy a boat cruise of the lagoon of Walvis Bay (boat cruise is included) where you will spot many differed ocean-dwellers. Explore Swakopmund on your own in the afternoon. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 4: After breakfast, drive along the Skeleton Coast north via Henties Bay, past Cape Cross and via Uchabmund into the Skeleton Coast National Park. Continue via Terra and Terrace Bay to Möwe Bay. Here you will be welcomed and transferred to the stunning and secluded **Shipwreck Lodge**, situated inside the park among Namib dunes. Overnight here in a chalet with en-suite facilities. (Fully Inclusive)

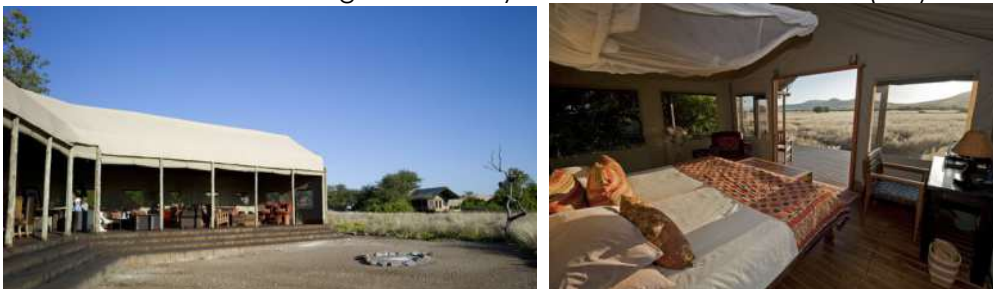


Day 5: Spend the day with your hosts and the offered activities. You will visit some highlights of the Skeleton Coast and you will discover many little treasures. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 6: Spend another day in these unique desert landscapes. Accommodation as on the previous day.

Day 7: After breakfast you will be transferred back to your vehicle. Drive south via Terrace Bay and inland via Springbockwasser to Damaraland and on via Palmwag to the secluded **Desert Rhino Camp**, situated in beautiful surroundings of the Damaraland-Kaokoland frontier. Overnight in a luxury tent with en-suite facilities. (Fully Inclusive)



Day 8: Spend the day with your hosts and the offered activities. You might spot a hook-lipped rhinoceros or an elusive desert adapted elephant. Accommodation as on the previous day.

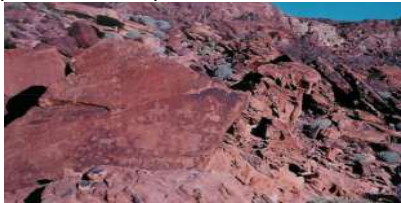


Day 9: Enjoy another day in the characteristic commiphora damarana flora of the Damaraland-Kaokoland frontier. Accommodation as on the previous day.

Day 10: Today, drive south through the stunning landscapes of Damaraland to the Twyfelfontein area. Overnight here in a chalet with en-suite facilities at the beautifully situated **Mowani Mountain Camp**. (Fully Inclusive)



Day 11: Visit the age-old rock engravings at Twyfelfontein, a world heritage site, and enjoy the beautiful scenery of Damaraland with your hosts. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 12: Visit the Petrified Forest and drive via Khorixas and Kamanjab via the Galton gate into the western part of the famous Etosha National Park. Drive through the park – while viewing game – via Okaukuejo and the Andersson gate to the **Ongava Lodge**. Overnight in a chalet with en-suite facilities at this lodge, which is situated just outside the park in a private game reserve. (Fully Inclusive)



Day 13: Guided game-viewing drives in the central-western part of Etosha. Large numbers of antelope, giraffe and zebra - and the predators that stalk them, and huge, dusty elephants against the backdrop of the vast Etosha Pan are characteristic of the days in the park. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 14: After breakfast, drive via Outjo, Otjiwarongo, Okahandja and the capital Windhoek to the Hosea Kutako International Airport, where your guide will bid you farewell or return your rented vehicle here. Flight home (your flight needs to depart in the evening!).
