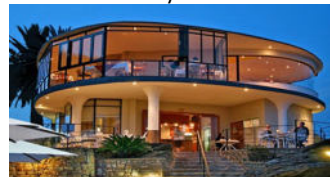

SAFARI IN NAMIBIA TO ALL HIGHLIGHTS: WINDHOEK, SOUTHERN KALAHARI, FISH RIVER CANYON, NAMIB DESERT, SOSSUSVLEI, SKELETON COAST, DAMARALAND, ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK, THE NORTHERN KALAHARI IN THE LUSH KAVANGO REGIONS AND THE CENTRAL HIGHLANDS



Short note about the following itinerary: The services mentioned in brackets are referring to the option **Self-Drive Safari!** The option **Guided Safari** includes all services as specified at the end of the itinerary.

Day 1: Arrival at the Windhoek Hosea Kutako International Airport in beautiful Namibia. Pick up your rented vehicle at the airport and drive to town. Alternatively, your **ONDESE** guide will welcome you here. Drive to town and overnight in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Hotel Thule**. (Bed and Breakfast)



Day 2: Drive south via Rehoboth and Kalkrand to the **Kalahari Anib Lodge**, situated in a privately-owned game reserve on the edge of the southern Kalahari. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 3: An early departure via Mariental and Keetmanshoop will bring you to the Quiver Tree Forest and then on via the Naute dam to the spectacular Fish River Canyon. Overnight here in a chalet with en-suite facilities at the **Cañon Lodge**. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 4: Today, visit the famous Fish River Canyon, a vast, deep and convoluted incision in the rugged landscape. Accommodation as on the previous day.



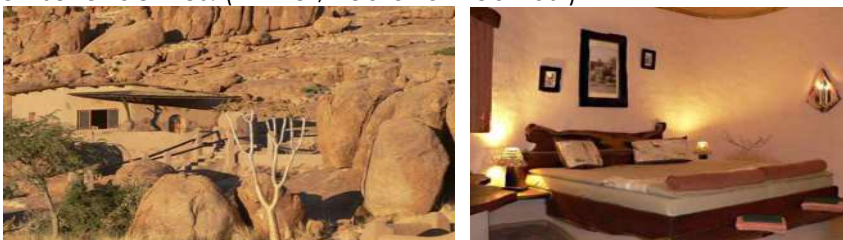
Day 5: Drive west via Aus through the picturesque southern Namib Desert and the restricted Diamond Area to the little harbour town of Lüderitzbucht. Overnight in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Lüderitz Nest Hotel**. (Bed and Breakfast)



Day 6: During the morning undertake a boat cruise to Halifax and the African Penguin (included). Visit the ghost town Kolmannskuppe, Dias Point and the surrounding bays. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 7: Drive inland through the desert and visit the wild horses at Garub. Continue via Aus through the breathtaking landscapes of the Neisip and Tiras plains to **Koimasis Farm Fest Inn Fels Lodge** on the edge of the desert. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 8: Today, you can visit the legendary Duwisib Castle. Drive along the edge of the Namib Desert through beautiful desert landscapes to the **Le Mirage Desert Lodge**, south of Sesriem. Overnight here in a luxury room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 9: Rising early to see the subtle colours of the morning sun over the Namib's highest dunes at Sossusvlei is definitely worthwhile (This guided excursion is included.). Later, visit the interesting Sesriem Canyon. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 10: After having acquired a permit at Sesriem, drive via Solitaire, the Tropic of the Capricorn, the Gaub and Kuiseb passes through the Namib-Naukluft National Park to see ancient Welwitschia plants and the Moon Landscape. Continue to the charming coastal town of Swakopmund and overnight in a room with en-suite facilities of the **Beach Hotel Swakopmund**. (Bed and Breakfast)



Day 11: Today, enjoy a boat cruise with fresh oysters in Walvis Bay during the morning (included). Spend the afternoon on your own in Swakopmund with its imposing architecture of the German colonial period. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 12: After breakfast, drive along the Skeleton Coast via Henties Bay inland through the Namib Desert via Uis to see the age-old rock engravings at Twyfelfontein, a world heritage site. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Twyfelfontein Country Lodge**. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 13: Visit the Petrified Forest and drive via Khorixas to the impressive Rock Finger (Vingerklip). Continue via Outjo to the **Etosha Village**, situated just outside of the renowned Etosha National Park in a private game reserve. Enjoy your own or guided game-viewing activities in the central-western part of Etosha. Overnight in a luxury tent with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 14: Take a game drive along the marked roads of the central and eastern part of Etosha in your rented vehicle. If you are on a guided safari, your guide can explain animal behaviour, population dynamics, habitat and food preferences, and more. Visit the historical Fort Namutoni. Overnight in a comfortable chalet with en-suite facilities at **Etosha Aoba Lodge**, situated outside the park. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 15: Game drives in eastern Etosha. Large numbers of antelope, giraffe and plains-zebra – and the predators that stalk them, and huge, dusty elephants against the backdrop of the vast Etosha Pan are characteristic of the days in the park. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 16: Visit Lake Oshikoto and drive via Tsumeb and Grootfontein into the northern Kalahari and the communal land of the Kavango Regions and continue to Rundu. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities at the **Tambuti Lodge** in the town, offering a view of the Okavango River. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



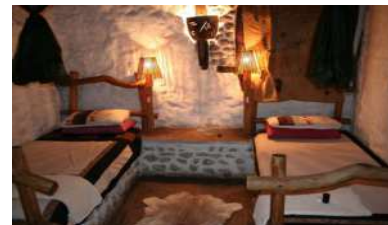
Day 17: Drive along the Okavango River via Andara and Divundu to the **Nunda River Lodge**, situated close to the Popa Rapids on the banks of the River. Overnight in a room or tent with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 18: Visit the Mahango section of the Bwabwata National Park. You may see elephant, buffalo, lechwe, sable and roan antelope, perhaps even lion. Accommodation as on the previous day.



Day 19: Today, drive west and south again via Rundu and Mururani to **Roy's Rest Camp**. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast) Relax in this calm atmosphere.



Day 20: In the course of the day, drive via Grootfontein to visit the world's largest meteorite on Farm Hoba. Continue via Otjiwarongo (here you might visit a crocodile farm) and Okahandja to just before the Namibian capital Windhoek to **Okapuka Safari Lodge**, situated in a private game reserve. Overnight here in a room with en-suite facilities. Game activities can be booked directly. (Dinner, Bed and Breakfast)



Day 21: Drive via Windhoek to the Hosea Kutako International Airport and return your rented vehicle here or allow your guide to transfer you from town to the airport for your flight out.
